### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS FINANCIAL AID OFFER

- A. You must inform the Law School Financial Aid Office in writing immediately after you are awarded assistance not previously disclosed or listed on this Award Notice, if your financial situation changes, or if you are employed for a different time period than that already declared.
- B. If requested, recipients of grants must correspond with the donor of their grant funds. Failure to do so by the requested deadline date will decrease or eliminate grant assistance.
- C. You must be enrolled full time (at least 10 hours). Exceptions to this policy are rare and must be approved in advance by this Office. Exceptions will be made only under extraordinary circumstances.
- D. You must not be in default on any student loans or owe a refund for aid previously received.
- E. Although a Law School Grant does not impose a legal obligation to repay the funds, the Law School hopes that those who receive grants will recognize that continuation of the grant program for future students will depend upon donation, when the recipients are able to do so, of an amount at least equal to the assistance they were given.
- F. Your acceptance of this aid offer authorizes the Law School Financial Aid Office to apply grants, loans and federal Stafford Loans awarded for your use directly to your University account to pay tuition, fees and/or University housing charges.
- G. You must inform the Law School Financial Aid Office in writing should you withdraw from the Law School, if you drop to less than full-time or if you are asked to leave the Law School for academic reasons.
- H. You may use funds listed here only for educational costs related to attendance at the Law School, which include living expenses for the academic year.
- I. You must use the aid listed here solely for educationally related expenses incurred during the academic period for which they are authorized.
- J. Should you fail to meet the terms of this aid offer, you may be asked to repay all or part of the aid you received, and/or you may jeopardize your future eligibility for aid.
- K. Payments will not be released until the first day of classes for the term the awards were designated.
- L. This financial aid offer is granted only for the academic year listed on this award. There is no express assumption that a similar aid package will be offered in subsequent years.
