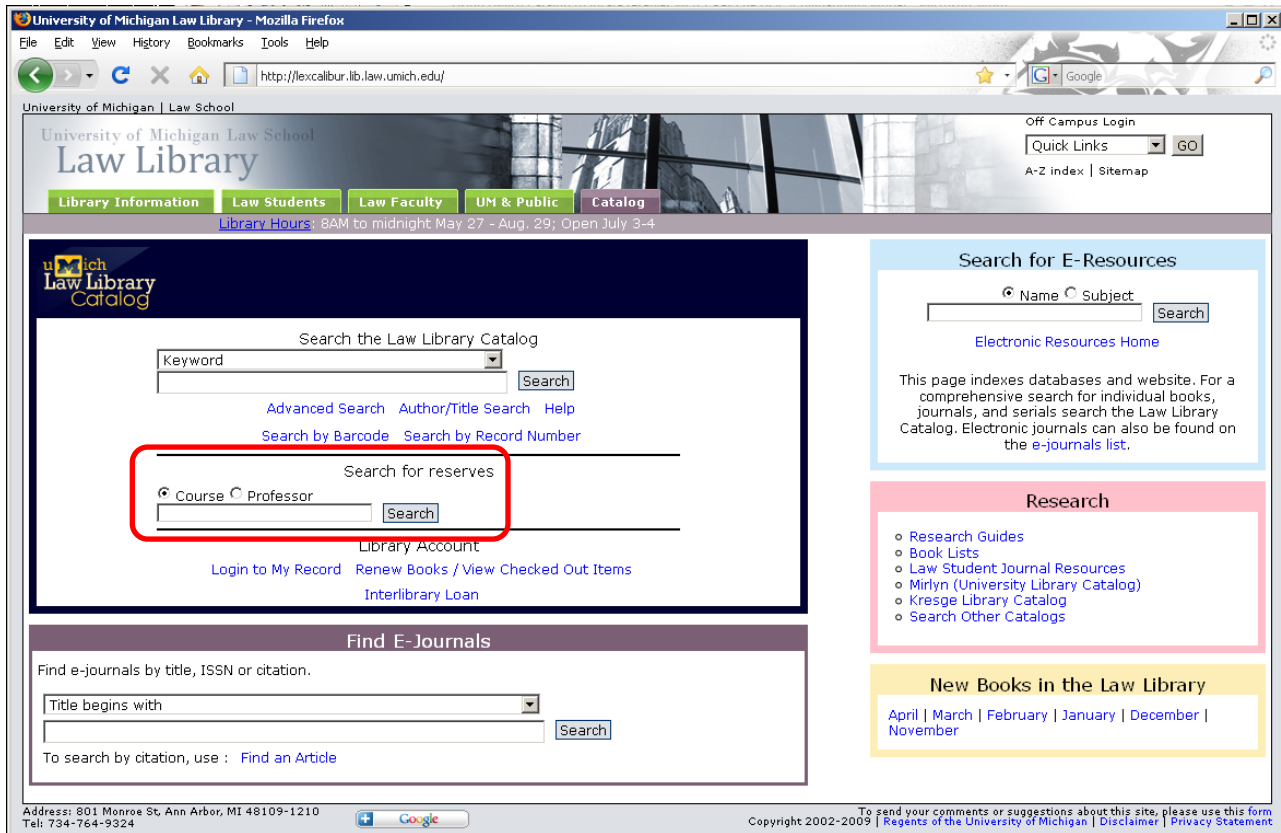


Modus Operandi

Using the UMich Law Library Catalog to Locate Reserves

Lists on the UMich Library Catalog:

The UMich Law Library system, which contains the online catalog, also provides access to lists of reserve materials. When looking at the catalog (<http://lexcalibur.lib.law.umich.edu/>), note that you can search course reserves by either "course" or "professor".



Searching

by professor: To search by professor, type the last name of the professor first. If there is more than one professor by that last name, you will get a screen asking you which one you want. If the professor is teaching more than one course, you will get a list of courses being taught and can choose which one you want to see. For example:

Searching

by course:

Type in the name of the course, e.g., *Contracts* or *Civil Procedure*; or, type in the number of the course. If the number is used, it should be preceded by the word **LAW**, e.g., *Law 848*. Rarely is a non-law school course listed, but in the instance that one is, it will be preceded by the name used in the course description, e.g., *His 614* (for HISTORY 614).
