Dr. Max Gabriel Cherem is an assistant professor of philosophy at Kalamazoo College. He received his PhD in philosophy from Northwestern University in 2012. His areas of specialization are social and political philosophy as well as ethics. His research focuses on issues of institutional political morality surrounding citizenship, immigration, refugees, human rights, and international law. He explored these themes in his dissertation from the perspective of Habermasian political philosophy. Over the last several years he has been working on several projects related to due process rights and the morally distinctive status of refugees. He will continue these projects next year at Duke University as a Visiting Faculty Fellow through the Humanities Writ Large initiative. He also serves as the assistant cross-country coach and pre-law adviser at Kalamazoo College.
