This letter is in follow up to my previous correspondence to you dated 5/22/14 regarding your public disclosure request, tracking #PDU-28299. The final installment, (installment #3) which totals 275 document pages, is ready to be disclosed.

You have requested the documents be disclosed electronically. The attachment is too large to attach to an email so the records are being offered to you on CD. The Department is currently reviewing its public disclosure policies and procedures with regard to providing records in electronic format. Pending completion of that review, we are examining requests for the release of records in electronic format on a case-by-case basis. Based on the facts and circumstances of your request and the records responsive to it, we have decided to provide records to you in electronic format (CD). However, this action neither signifies a change in the Department's policy, nor indicates that the Department will release records in electronic format in all cases upon request.
